

I work in a K-5 elementary library and have bought all the "I Survived..." books for my elementary boys - though plenty of girls have also enjoyed them. They love the "true story line", the fast pace of the books, and the fact that they are small chapter books. This is a high interest series that caters wonderfully to those reluctant readers.

My son has read all of these books. Great way to teach history through the eyes of fictional kids who "survived" the event. The author really brings history to life with the I Survived series. My son starting reading these a few years ago. He is 13 now and still asks for these books when a new one is released.

My 9 year old grandson didn't like to read until he started reading this book series. I only wish the author would write more!! Also, I order two of the same books by accident. I did the refund, and i didn't need to return the duplicate book.

I loved this book as a read aloud for my 3rd and 4th graders. I plan on adding this to novels we read in 3rd grade. As a series, I have found the "I Survived ..." books to be greatly motivating to reluctant readers, particularly boys.
