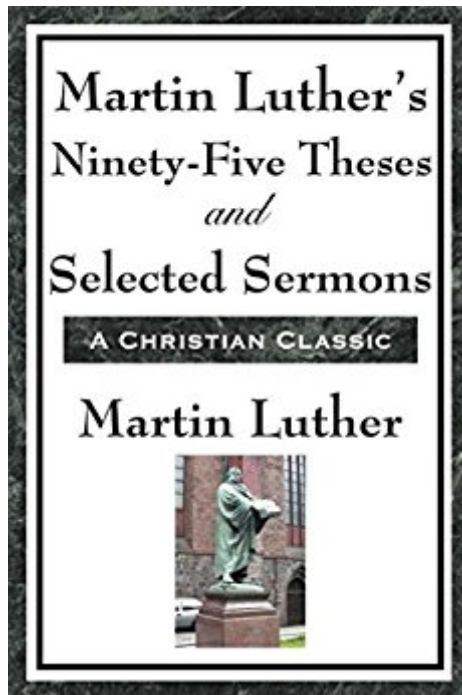




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# Martin Luther's Ninety-Five Theses And Selected Sermons

Also included in this edition are seven of Luther's most important sermons including Christ's Holy Sufferings, Enemies of the Cross of Christ & the Christian's Citizenship in Heaven, Christ Our Great High Priest, On Faith & Coming to Christ, Of The Office of Preaching, The Twofold Use of the Law & Gospel: "Letter" & "Spirit," and The Parable of the Sower.

This book reveals that even in the days of Martin Luther, the truth was the same as it is today (big surprise). The translation uses a fairly modern vocabulary, certainly easier to read than a lot of KJV Elizabethan english (if you're not used to it). This relatively brief document remains pivotal in studies of European history, since the church was such a vital part of life in Luther's day, so just for historical reasons, I recommend your reading this initial chapter!

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
