

In this very revealing book Gross, with power and wit exposes the uncontrolled spending in our government. In summary he says: "through investigative reporting, research and analysis, study of the budget documents, and interviews with scores of agency officials, the federal government will be dissected---in a non-partisan matter". Though I did find his treatment of doctors and social health care a bit off. From Agriculture to Zoos, these pages are filled with numerous short examples that focus on key spending programs that are squandering our money. Gross offers a simple solution for each example. If you are not already fed up with Washington enough, what is contained in this book will only exasperate your feelings more. Many government subsidies go to individuals that don't need them. This system of giveaways only encourages fraud. Many of these programs are obsolete but continue anyway. It is rare to find a government project that works.
