

the movies, and go out to a real restaurant. She was never allowed the simple freedoms that so many people take for granted. She had never done any of those things, and she wanted to do so much. Isabella slipped away from her security detail. Adham caught up to her, and he was ordered to take her to the palace. Adham and Isabella ended up doing some of things on her dream list. He loved the happiness that lit up her face with each new thing she tried. She was full of life, she was innocent, and wore her emotions on her sleeve.
