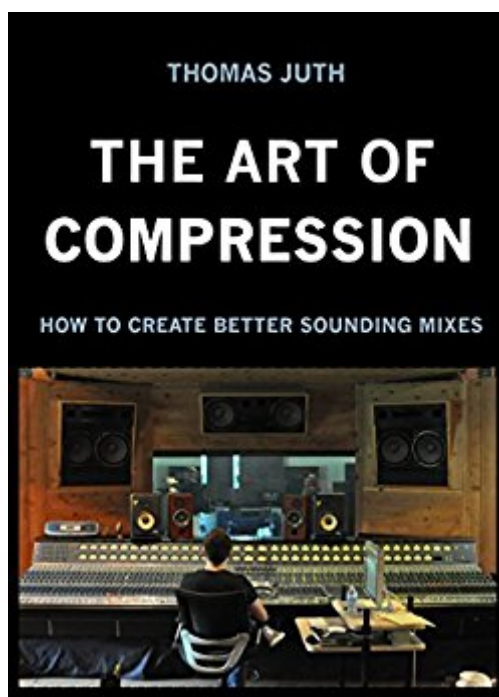

Short, but packed with practical information, especially for a newbie like me trying to find my way through this complex jungle of exotic technical gear to learn how to make simple, professional sounding demos. My only critique is that when he introduced his favorite compressors, I struggled to figure out what technical category they fit in. A small editing fix would help someone like me enormously. That said, you'll get your \$4 worth in the first few pages.

The author helps you to not only consider compression as a tool to only reduce the dynamic range of a track but also as a tone and depth shaping tool or spice as he states. He even touched on advance concepts such as mixing the original and duplicates with different compressors to achieve interesting results. A more detailed explanation with links to audio examples would have helped but it is still a good book regardless.

This book has opened up my use of compression and to utilize it in different ways. Written well and easy to follow. I would recommend reading this book to all.

Clearly written but definitely assumes some basic knowledge of compression and engineering (as the author himself admits). I'm an amateur engineer but there were definitely a few helpful pieces of information I took away. It was a quick and easy read too.
