

Great, You've learned your first semester of Chinese. You've done the exercises, and you can READ most of the Chinese Characters, but you still struggle with WRITING them. Now you are on summer break, or you are taking Chinese second semester, and you need to review or relearn your writing skills. This book is just right: not too long, not too short. It takes the HSK level 1 characters you've learned, puts them in context, and allows you to practice your writing, review your reading, and also comes with common usage of the characters and a review section. I'll use it over the summer with my children (who are in an immersion Chinese School) to practice our writing so that we can start next Chinese School year with a head start! (Now if they just had a book with the Radicals used for the characters to complement this book, I'd be in TiÃ„Ã•ntÃ„Ã•ng.)
