

He is a Past President of the American Society of Criminology. Pamela Wilcox is Professor in the School of Criminal Justice at the University of Cincinnati. She is noted for developing "multicontextual opportunity theory." Her recent publications include *The Oxford Handbook of Criminological Theory*.
