This book from 2013 to 2017 has lost very much it is no longer worth buying. Mostly filled with filler you'll never use. Stuff that was good has been replaced with stuff from Juneau and Kodiak etc. Most places like the Fairbanks car museum or Stan Stevens tours have dropped from this book perhaps you should too. I'm sorry I bought it.

Friends of ours put us onto this book in 2007, the first time we went to Alaska. It is full of coupons that offer two admissions for a single price for many things you will want to do and see in Alaska. We are on our way back there right now in 2014 and we have the current edition. The book is just under \$100 and you will easily save 4-6 times that or more. It's also a perfect way to learn about things to do while you're in Alaska. The book is divided into regions, which makes it easy to plan your activities based on where you'll be in Alaska. Also, you should sign up for Scott's Alaska Travelgram e-mails. He learns about airfare bargains that will save you big money.

The book did help us save good amount money- about \$500 between two of us. It would be great if there were more local service providers participate including hotels, B&B, restaurants and activities. But for some of the most popular expensive activities, often there are no coupons, such as some of the cruises, helicopter tours, guided fishing tours. For lots of us, we are working class, and do not want spend arms and legs to have Alaska guided fishing experience-usually \$400/person in addition to the cost of getting fishing license, all kinds of fees.

This book will be saving us tons of money on various activities during our trip to Alaska next week. I

would recommend buying the book in early January if you are planning a summer trip. I bought my book only recently, so the lodging coupons weren't helpful since the places were already booked. That would have been a different story if I had made a January purchase. Buying this book is a no-brainer if you're going someplace as expensive as Alaska!

Trip to Alaska would have been more costly and less touristy without this book. Even if you don't want to fish there are worthwhile coupons in this book altho the concentration is on fishing, (or so it seems to a non-fisher)

By scoring a two-for-one coupon for an excursion priced at \$169 each, I've already covered the cost of this collection of discounted deals. I see at least two or three other offers that I may take advantage of. Since many tours and attractions in Alaska are quite pricey, I am pleased to find this money-saver. I will probably have more fun on vacation next month than I would have had without it.

I was utterly disappointed by the usefulness (or lack of) of the coupons. First, they have very limited collection unless you are literally touring every part of Alaska. Second, deals are offered by vendors, who you otherwise may not patronize. Even for the areas I could find a coupon, I chose to go with alternate options as they were both better and economically comparable even after factoring in the deal.
