

As she begins to piece together her past, she discovers everything may not be as it appears. The mystery unravels as Grace searches for clues to her past. Although I will admit I had inklings of how this plot would unfold, I was not completely sure, as *Broken Grace* took twists and turns through the character development of Grace's sister, Lisa, and her dead boyfriend/fiance, Michael, of whom she can only recall bits and pieces. Were Grace's parents bad people, as Lisa suggests, or was there some other twisted mind seeking to better his or her own cause? Was Grace cheating on her boyfriend, or was he cheating on her? Did she kill Michael? This is a book I sometimes didn't want to put down. Highly recommended.

I felt the story was well written and had a few twists and turns--but for me, fairly predictable. I like thrillers that keep me guessing but this one didn't. I figured it out early on so the ending was no big surprise. I did read the entire book because I wanted to know what was truly behind Grace's amnesia and her dysfunctional childhood. So there was something of substance to keep me reading, but it was a mediocre plot in my opinion.

Very engrossing storyline. The mystery of the killer is not all that mysterious. I figured it out early in the book, and I am not really that astute in solving mysteries, yet *Broken Grace* is a likeable character who discovers an horrific past and overcomes tons of adversity. The ending is romantic and predictable, but still sucked me in. It is not a book that you can't put down, but it is definitely an enjoyable book for crime and mystery lovers.

Very disappointed. The author started out extremely well, and actually, by the end, the story had a few twists, although not enough to redeem it. One frustration for me for example, was the fact that from my perspective, whenever the author couldn't figure out how to proceed, he/she dropped in an F-bomb and somehow got the story rolling again. After awhile, it drove me insane. I finished the book and thought the ending was fair. What surprised me the most were the incredible questions for "book-club" users at the end. If the author would have put as much care into keeping the story clean

and moving like the questions at the end, the book might have been an exceptional read. Sorry, the gratuitous F-bombs did me in, rating this book a two-star only.

This book was surprisigly good! After my last bad experience with Prime's book of the month my expectations were pretty low, and this book exceeded them on all accounts. The story was captivating, interesting throughout the novel, all the characters were really well developed and each one had a past or a background. The investigation took turns and twists, as did the emotional attachment towards the characters - at times it was impossible to know who to root for, or who the 'good guy'is. This was honestly a really interesting read and I would have payed money for it if I haven't gotten it for free. If you like crimes, investigation, drama, and going back into the past this is a story for you. Also the descriptions of Grace's state of mind and health after the accident are excellent, really make you feel what she is feeling and empathize with her. Give it a try!

This book is full of twists and turns. A man is murdered and his finance has an auto accident the same day which leaves her without any memory. There are several villains in this book and one was easy to determine. Very surprising ending. I enjoyed this book --listened to it.

Grace is fleeing down a highway when her car collides with a deer. She awakes in a hospital with serious injuries and no memory. Her sister arrives to take her home and care for her while she recovers from her injuries and hopefully regains her memory. The house her sister lives in belonged to her deceased parents. Why is Grace so afraid in the house? The police arrive to tell her her boyfriend was murdered. Did Grace do it? The police seem to think so, but Grace is having nightmares and flashes from the past as she begins to recover her memory. Will everyone be happy about the prospect of her remembering? This book is a fine psychological thriller with plenty of twists and turns ending in a surprising conclusion. There are slow spots, as is always the case where much of the "action", occurs in the mind of the protagonist, but these patches are well worth enduring for the punch that the novel delivers.
