

In the instructive foreword, she describes the eight fundamental crystal structures, historical uses, and elemental formation. She also gives directions for activating crystals' cleansing and healing properties and discusses their relationship to chakras. I was excited by the historical insights offered by Å¢Â ªA Lapidary of Sacred StonesÅ¢Â • by Claude Lecouteux and Isidore KozminskyÅ¢Â ™s Å¢Â ªCrystals, Jewels, Stones: Magic & ScienceÅ¢Â • but I was downright thrilled to be given access to the practical, revised and expanded edition of, Å¢Â ªThe Encyclopedia of CrystalsÅ¢Â • by Judy Hall. You may recognize HallÅ¢Â ™s name as the author of Å¢Â ªCrystals and Sacred Sites: Use Crystals to Access the Power of Sacred Landscapes for Personal and Planetary TransformationÅ¢Â • that I reviewed here on The Buffet. Well, when Hall isnÅ¢Â ™t busy proposing new theories on how to use crystals sheÅ¢Â ™s authoring some of the most definitive guides to minerals and gemstones. So why are her books some of the best out there? Glad you asked. My favorite feature, and the most obvious, is that the crystals are laid out (or listed if you prefer) in the book by color. How great is that? Hey, I have this purple stone and I canÅ¢Â ™t remember what it is. No problem, IÅ¢Â ™ll pull out the Å¢Â ªEncyclopediaÅ¢Â • and flip to the purple section and see what it matches up with. How awesome is that? But I know what stone I want to read about! Again, not a problem. There is an alphabetical crystal index at the front of the book and there is a thorough index in the back of the book as well. There is also a short but very informative introduction that covers everything from basic geology to the chakras. Each stone is given a fantastic image or two to help with identification. Then they list: crystal system, chemistry, hardness, source, chakra, number, zodiac sign, planet, and what itÅ¢Â ™s beneficial for. After that there is a paragraph with historical and folkloric detail. Judy HallÅ¢Â ™s Å¢Â ªEncyclopedia of CrystalsÅ¢Â • is an absolute must own for anyone interested in minerals and gemstones. If youÅ¢Â ™re going to own just one book as a resource on crystals, this is the

one.
