

I've been a fan of Marcos Mateu-Mestre's work ever since discovering 'Framed Ink', which quickly became one of my most recommended art books. I'm happy to say, these new volumes live up to every bit of my expectations. *Framed Perspective Volume 2* picks up where *Volume 1* leaves off. Primarily, it focuses on how light and shadow fall on objects in perspective. Admittedly, this can get pretty advanced at times (ie. how long is the shadow from a steeple across a staggered roof?), but the resource of information is invaluable. For me, the highlight of the book (and the majority of its focus), is how Marcos describes and deconstructs the human form into simple geometric shapes so that you can apply the very same lighting principals to lighting the human figure. Aside from a few notable exceptions (ie. Burne Hogarth's Dynamic Lighting), I can think of VERY few other books that delve into the subject of creating accurate lighting from imagination. Aside from the wonderful cache of information in this book, much like *Framed Ink*, it is chock full of beautiful drawings that are sure to impress any artist. I think this book would be a great value at even double the cover price.
