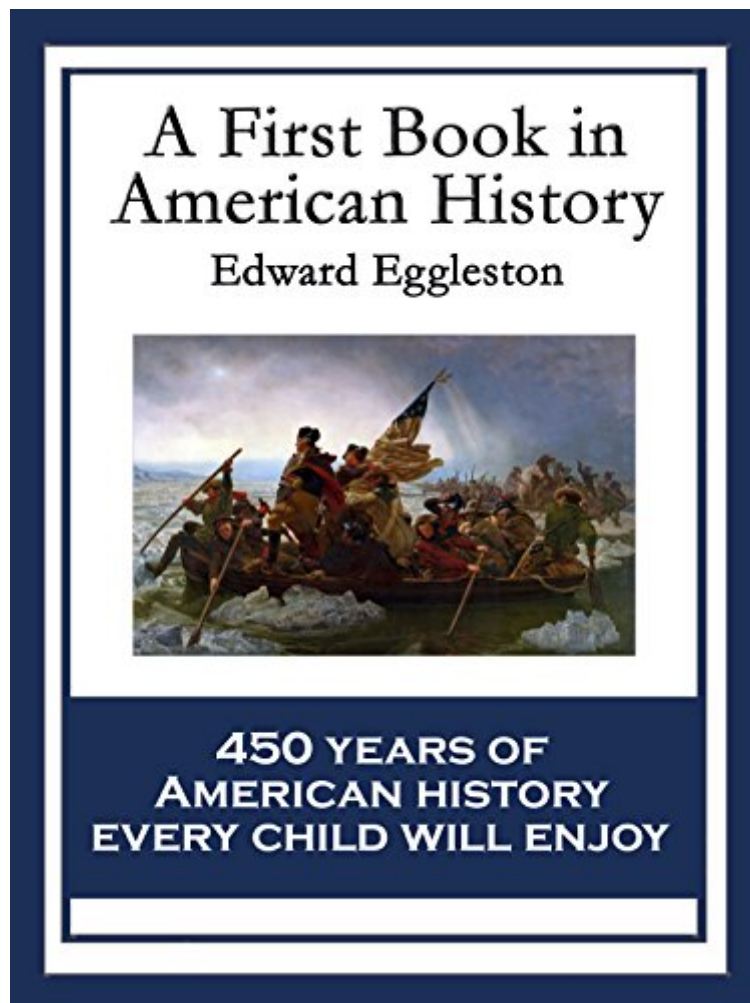

I purchased the paperback version to use with our Homeschool curriculum : Heart of Dakota - Bigger Hearts for His Glory. The page numbers don't match up to the hardback version, so I had to do some work to figure out what we should read every day. Also, there was a mention in one of the first chapters about the picture on the page. Unfortunately, this book doesn't contain pictures as mentioned. Otherwise, it's a great compilation of American History biographies. My daughter is almost 8 yo, and she is enjoying the stories so far.

The kindle edition costs substantially less yet in the description it says "with maps and illustrations." However, there are no maps and illustrations -- text only. I am using this with a homeschool curriculum, and when the curriculum says to refer to a map in the book for an activity, I'm left without. So, if you'll be needing the illustrations as well (which always make it more interesting to the student) you may want to spend the extra money on the print edition.**Two and a half months later it looks like the description has been changed and states "no illustrations" for the Kindle edition.
