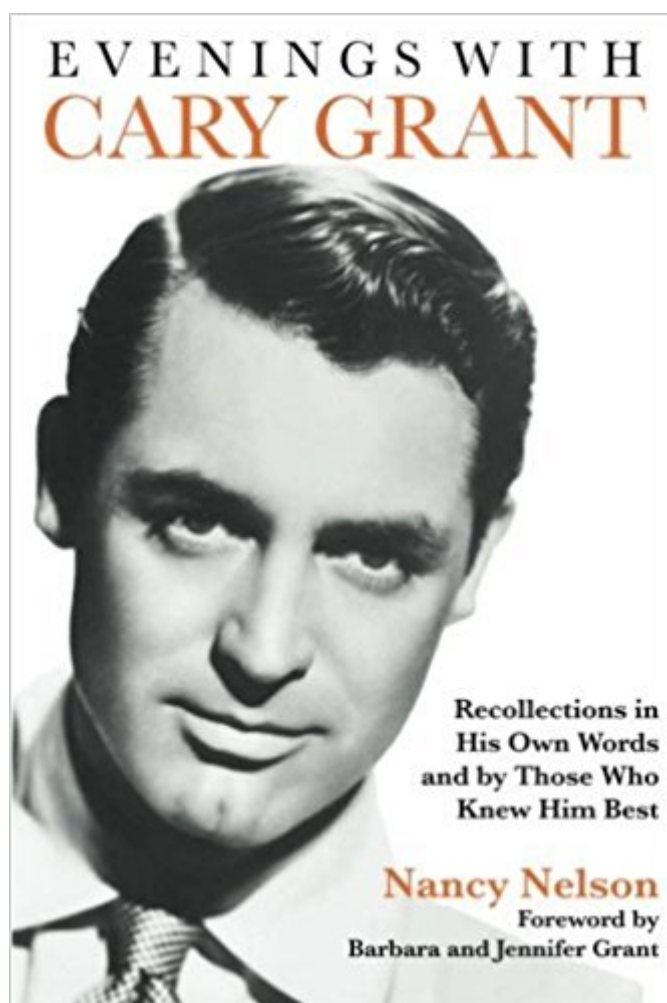


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Evenings With Cary Grant: Recollections In His Own Words And By Those Who Knew Him Best

He was a humble man because of his origins and a very deep thinker.
