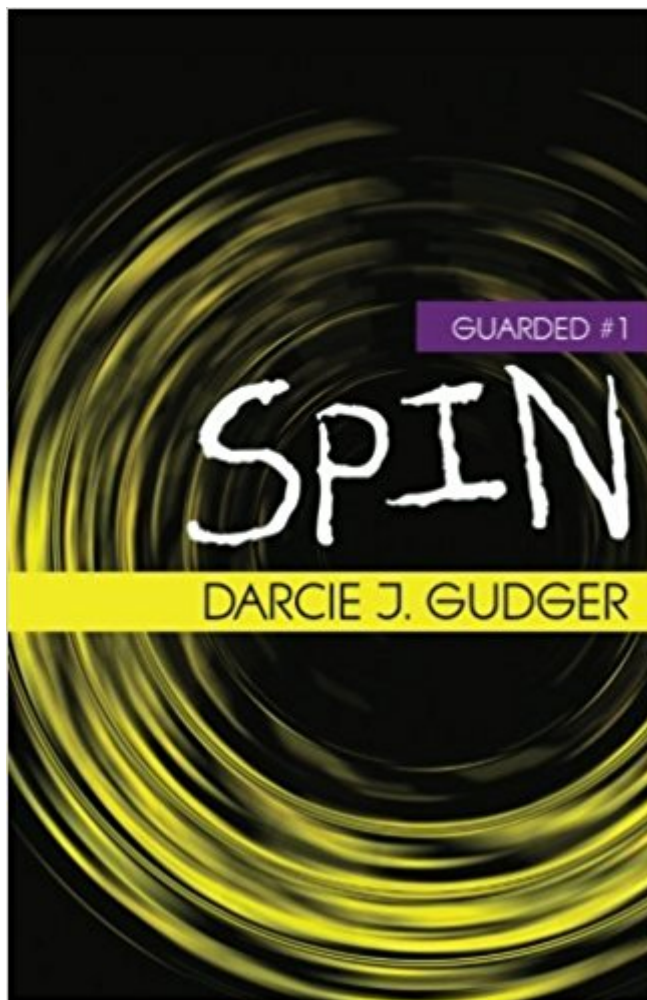

A stunning debut! Author Darcie Gudger gives us a wonderful story of forgiveness, loyalty, courage, and friendship. I couldn't put this book down. I loved the main theme of *Spin* : do the right thing even when no one else will stand with you and it doesn't seem like you'll make a difference. *Spin* contains many humorous situations but also many serious ones. Mrs. Gudger's writing can be laugh-out-loud funny, but serious when it needs to be. The character's emotions were conveyed well. Several chapters are written from Wendy's (the bully) POV, and so the reader begins to understand her. I so badly wanted her to get what she deserved, but I also couldn't help but feel sorry for her. This girl is nasty, but I began to sympathize with her. By the end of *Spin* , the reader fully understands Wendy's motivations. Mrs. Gudger's addition of Wendy's perspective added a certain level of depth not many YA novels can boast of. I would recommend *Spin* to older teens, as the book deals with some tough, mature issues. Book two, please!
