

I like the way David thinks, his view of possible futures is what good science fiction is all about.

One of my favorite aspects of a good Sci-Fi, is a writer with a great technological mind who makes the fictitious future more believable. That, along with the well thought out plots, characters, and use of mystery have made this one of my all time favorites, and I read a lot of Sci-Fi. I really enjoyed the first 4 books of the Post-Human series.

I started this series with books 2 and 3, finished up with 1 and 4 when I got the whole collection. The series as a whole was extremely satisfying and managed to do well in almost all important areas. It had well developed characters, good plot pacing and a varied plot (not the usual stagger from one battle to the next). Perhaps most importantly each book fed into the next but each was a distinct story. There is a benefit to reading them in order but it is not essential. I'm looking forward to more from this author.

I just finished the first four books of the Post-Human series and would say that I "devoured" them. I moved from each one to the next so quickly this might as well have been one long novel. David Simpson did a good job of transitioning to the next evolution of man through each book. And he kept around the key players, so I felt invested in the next book immediately upon starting it. Well, OK, he

fooled me in one of them, but once I figured it out, I was once again captured by the story. I look forward to book 5 and anything else he writes. Maybe he can even go back and write some prequels (you know, before this is made into a movie, hint, hint).

Started the book series and the experience reading all has been entertaining. My only amazement came on the Human-Plus book on the hellish torture moment's where strong. Certainly not a novel for young readers because of those instances.
