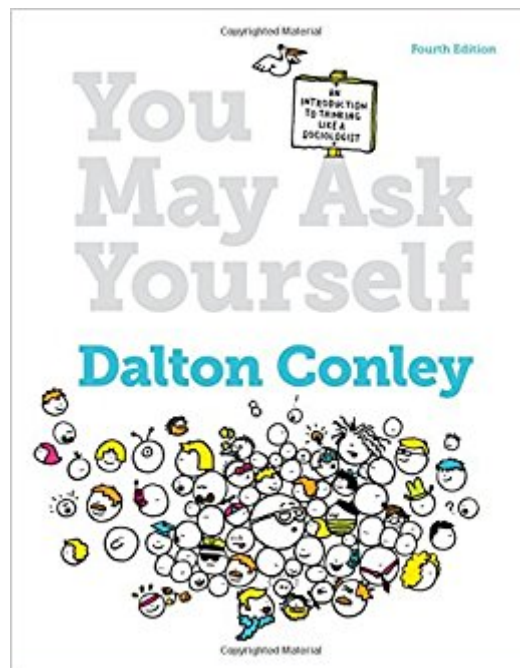




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You May Ask Yourself: An Introduction To Thinking Like A Sociologist (Fourth Edition)
