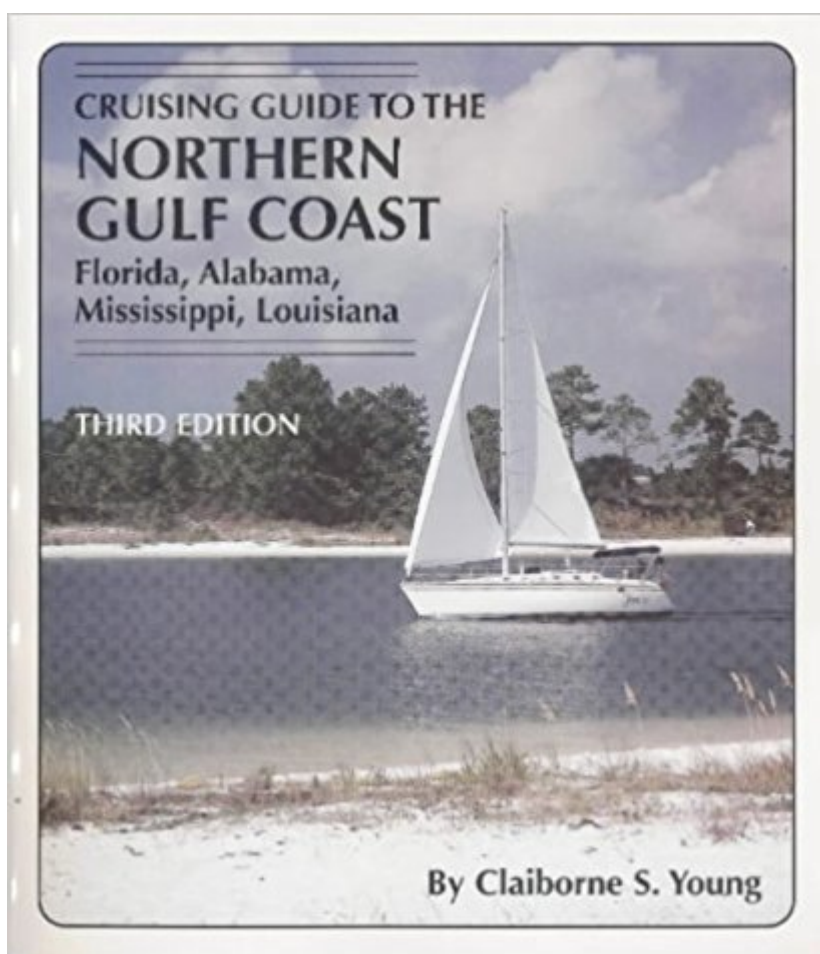

He has even devised a dockage fee-rating system, so cruisers can choose a "below-average-," "average-," or "above-average-priced" marina. Like all of Young's guides, Cruising Guide to the Northern Gulf Coast combines expert navigational advice with candid evaluations of facilities, marinas, restaurants, and other shoreside attractions. This edition of the cruising guide is also cross-referenced to the current NOAA maps in Coastal Charts for Cruising Guide to the Northern Gulf Coast. Claiborne S. Young's books for Pelican have become the gold standard for cruising guides. A resident of Snow Camp, North Carolina, Young also edits the on-line cruising newsletter The Salty Southeast. The guide itself is typical of a Claiborne Young cruising guide, which I have many. They have always been well written and accurate. What disappoints me concerning this guide is the title. The title says Cruising Guide To, Louisiana. This is not accurate, and is very misleading. The guide covers nothing west of New Orleans. The area from New Orleans to the Sabine River is the reason the Cruising Guide was purchased. For me it was a wasted purchase.

Weak content on barrier islands
Nothing west of New Orleans
Terribly out of date regarding shore services
Waste of money

This guide should not be sold. The content is 10 years old, which is unacceptable in a cruising guide. The yellowed pages are of newsprint quality - not suitable at all for use on a boat.
