Long's latest is grand in scale and in delivery. What if you accidentally became a superhero? Would you be super? Or even a hero? One thing Mr. Long has always done well is develop characters that are not only understandable, but relatable. You either **are** or **know** the people he writes. In "Impact Earth: Symbiosis", he excels by creating characters that are so real that I could sometimes physically relate to what they were going through. His ability to paint a picture of action (and destruction) moves the story along quickly, not in a confusing rush, but a progressive crescendo of action, violence, will, and power. I'm looking forward to Book 2.

I liked most of the characters, I liked the setting and overall story, but I did not like the layout and story progression. The book layout is a rotation between the characters when every character gets one chapter every time, so it's like this: Character 1 Chapter Character 2 Chapter Character 3 Chapter Character 4 Chapter Character 5 Chapter Character 1 Chapter Character 2 Chapter Character 3 ... Now the problem with that is that the time frame and major events are the same for 5 chapters, every time from a different character's perspective and experience so you get a slightly different angle because the view point is through character number 2 instead of the previous character number 1 but for me it wasn't different enough, especially at the first half of the book with the alien invasion and power implementation, when it switched to character number 4 chapter and I had to read all over again about "the big fire ball in the sky, is it a meteorite? is it a classified US craft? who knows?" I nearly stopped reading the book because of it.

I only ran into one problem of note and it was toward the end of the book, Guy was worried about the girl he had met and it said he had no way to contact her, not even a phone number. A few lines later it mentions having her number in his wallet. This mistake took me out of the flow, as I had to think back to remember if she'd even given him the number. She did. Overall a fun read that I enjoyed. I will be getting the sequel. Won't you join me?

I had no idea what to expect. The characters were flawed and almost unlikable. Then as I watched them grow in the book I began to like each one and their flaws. I had no idea what was going to happen, plenty of twists that really held my attention. This was an excellent read that I had to finish

in one session. The action, humor, and plot really held me the entire time.

I really enjoyed this book, a different take on alien invasion with a cool inclusion of talented people are bit like the x-men. Nicely paced and jumps from character to character narrative, enough to keep it interesting but still build character depth. I'll definitely be buying book 2.
