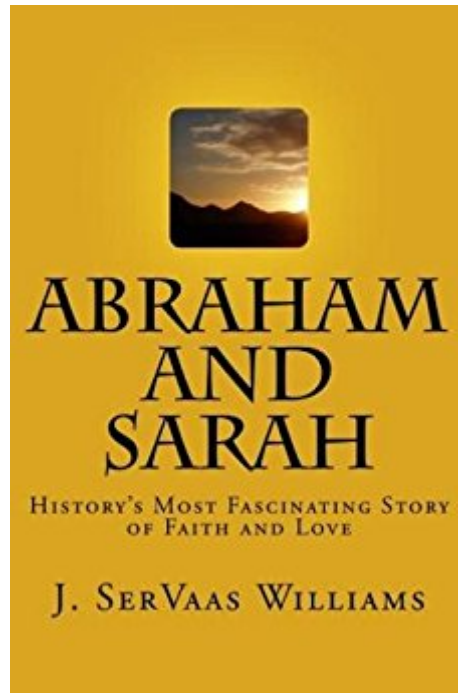




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ABRAHAM AND SARAH

This is a fictional account of how Abram became Abraham and Sarai became Sarah. It skillfully wove history, scripture and fiction together into a compelling story that begins before Abram and Sarai meet. The author includes many familiar Bible characters like Lot and his wife. It speaks of the beautiful Sarai who is just a few generations from Noah, and Abram who is quite intelligent and a righteous man.
